

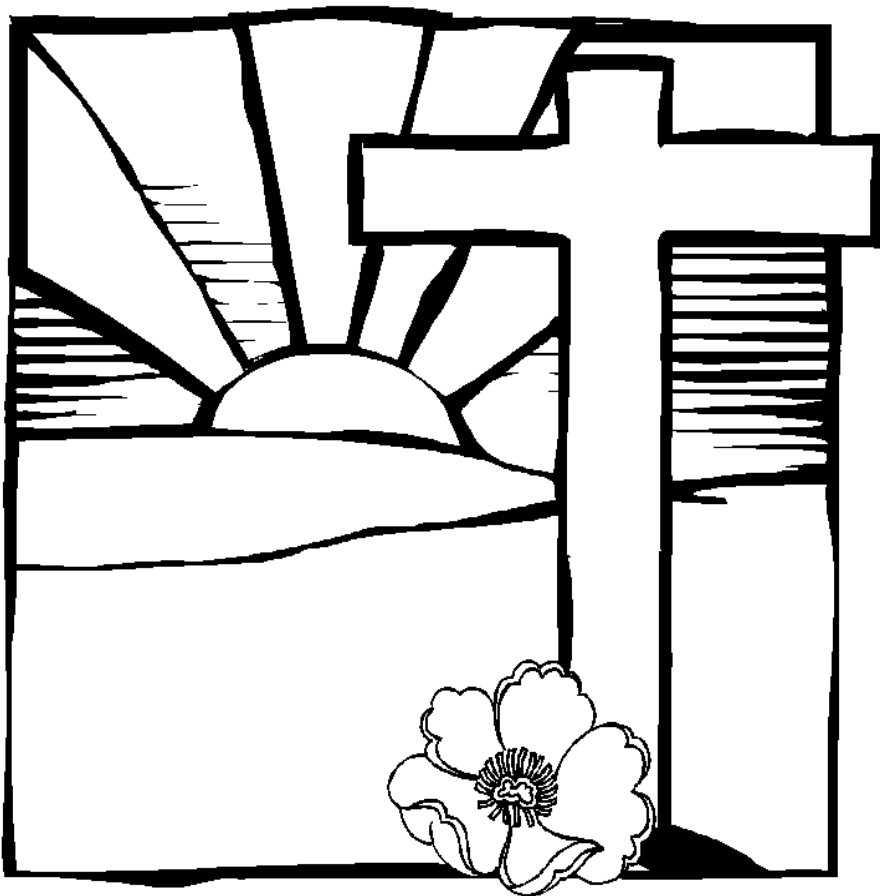

Here is a picture of poppies for you to colour.



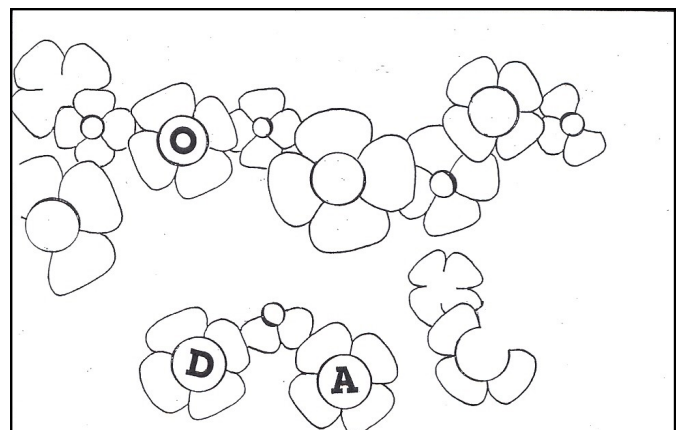
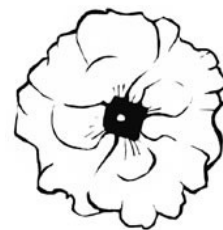
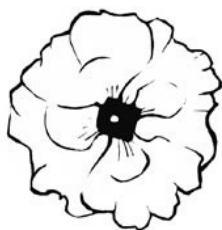
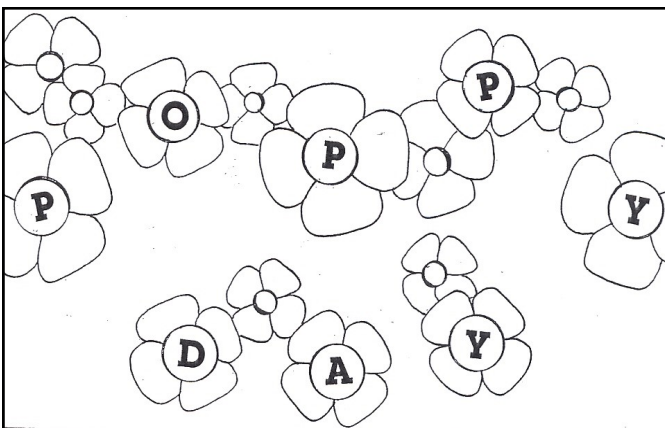

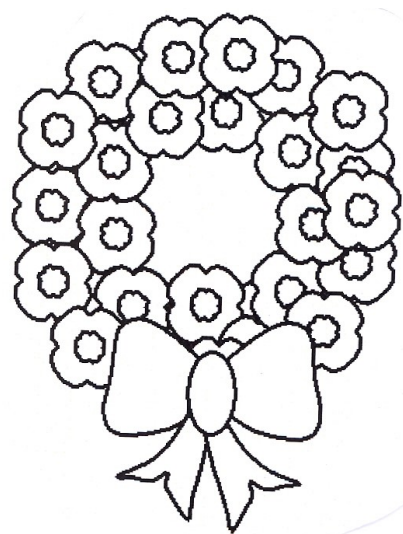
