

HIRE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. A deposit of £50 is required returnable less any deductions (see 10 and 11 below) once the hired area/s has/have been checked and cleaned.
2. Payments must be received one month before the date.
3. The church is in a residential area therefore noise must be kept to reasonable levels.
4. The church Health and safety policy requires any electrical appliances that you may bring onto the premises to have been PAT tested within the past year. If hiring a bouncy castle to use on our premises, please check that it is PAT tested and the hirer has insurance.
5. It is a requirement of the hire agreement, that the person/ group hiring the premises is required to have, either its own safeguarding policies and procedures, or agrees to comply with the relevant safeguarding guidance issued by the church. The church safeguarding policy can be found in the hub and can be viewed whenever the church is open. It can also be viewed on the church website.
6. Any person /group hiring the premises must ensure that children, young people, and adults at risk are always protected. If relevant, paid staff and volunteers should have appropriate DBS checks, and that all reasonable steps have been taken to prevent injury, illness, loss, or damage occurring.
7. No alcohol may be sold without a temporary licence.
8. The church will not allow events such as Halloween parties which are contrary to the ethics of the Christian Faith.
9. No smoking is allowed in the buildings or on the grounds.
10. Breakages and damages must be paid for, including any damage to walls. Please do not use pins Sellotape or Blu tack on walls or remove organisation notices. The cost of any replacement/making good that the church must undertake will be deducted from the deposit.
11. At the end of the booking, the kitchen must be clean, rubbish sorted for recycling and taken out to the appropriate bins, toilets checked, flushed and clean, furniture wiped and put back, and the floor swept clean. The costs of any additional cleaning the church must undertake will be deducted from the deposit.
